### **Essential Duties:**


- Respond to medical emergencies and other calls for assistance
- Performs Paramedic duties, follows protocols and maintains proficiency.
- Participates in continuing and advanced medical training programs and drills
- Trains and maintains good physical condition.
- Establishes and maintains effective working relationships with other employees, superiors, other agencies, and the public.
- Deals with the public in a manner that positively promotes the image of the City and handles complaints
- tactfully.
- Abides by all standards, conduct and policies, as stated in Personnel Policy Manual.
- This job description in no way states or implies that these are the only duties to be performed by this employee. He or she will be required to follow any other instructions and to perform any other duties requested by his or her supervisor.
- Clean and maintain the station and medical equipment and apparatus.

### **Skills:**

- Active Listening - Giving full attention to what other people are saying, taking time to understand the points being made, asking questions as appropriate, and not interrupting at inappropriate times.
- Critical Thinking - Using logic and reasoning to identify the strengths and weaknesses of alternative solutions, conclusions or approaches to problems.
- Coordination - Adjusting actions in relation to others' actions.
- Operation Monitoring - Watching gauges, dials, or other indicators to make sure a machine is working properly.
- Operation and Control - Controlling operations of equipment or systems.
- Monitoring - Monitoring/Assessing performance of yourself, other individuals, or organizations to make improvements or take corrective action.
- Reading Comprehension - Understanding written sentences and paragraphs in work related documents.
- Equipment Maintenance - Performing routine maintenance on equipment and determining when and what kind of maintenance is needed.
- Equipment Selection - Determining the kind of tools and equipment needed to do a job.
- Active Learning - Understanding the implications of new information for both current and future problem-solving and decision-making.
- Judgment and Decision Making - Considering the relative costs and benefits of potential actions to choose the most appropriate one.

### **Attributes:**

- Problem Sensitivity - The ability to tell when something is wrong or is likely to go wrong. It does not involve solving the problem, only recognizing there is a problem.
- Deductive Reasoning - The ability to apply general rules to specific problems to produce answers that make sense.
- Flexibility of Closure - The ability to identify or detect a known pattern (a figure, object, word, or sound) that is hidden in other distracting material.
- Static Strength - The ability to exert maximum muscle force to lift, push, pull, or carry objects.
- Multilimbed Coordination - The ability to coordinate two or more limbs (for example, two arms, two legs, or one leg and one arm) while sitting, standing, or lying down. It does not involve performing the activities while the whole body is in motion.
- Spatial Orientation - The ability to know your location in relation to the environment or to know where other objects are in relation to you.
- Memorization - The ability to remember information such as words, numbers, pictures, and procedures.
- Rate Control - The ability to time your movements or the movement of a piece of equipment in anticipation of changes in the speed and/or direction of a moving object or scene.

- Stamina - The ability to exert yourself physically over long periods of time without getting winded or out of breath.

**Physical Requirements:**

- Ability to perform heavy physical work and ability to lift and carry up to 100 pounds.
- Ability to move a person weighing over 200 pounds. Ability to carry hose while wearing breathing apparatus.
- Ability to talk and hear in person, by telephone, and two-way radio.
- Ability to see and read material and instructions and observe events at emergency
