### **Position Summary:**

Under general direction, performs semi skilled work in the operation of a wastewater treatment plant and related equipment and makes mechanical repairs and adjustments to equipment as required. Maintains grounds of treatment facility.

#### Tasks:

Works on a shift and inspects and operates, lubricates, and adjusts pumps and machinery; performs plant mechanical work; maintains pumps and bearings; installs back flow improvements; may weld; draws samples for laboratory tests and analyses; makes routine chemical analyses of samples; conducts visual inspections of working apparatus and grounds performing preventive maintenance on equipment; operates trucks and tractor mowers; disposes of sludge; performs custodial work in the cleaning and maintenance of equipment and facilities; paints; does grounds work; starts and stops pumps; does mechanical work as a part of maintenance.

# **Additional Duties**

fuels vehicles; picks up mail; picks up parts and supplies. performs other duties as assigned. Oversees and uses equipment and materials requiring care to assure against breakdown or deterioration; contact with others is incidental to performance of duties; duties require heavy physical work; duties require work to be performed in undesirable physical conditions; hazards require care and use of proper safety equipment and procedure to prevent injury.

# **Education, Training, and Experience Requirements:**

Any combination of education and experience equivalent to graduation from high school; possession of a valid driver's license.

- Plant and related equipment are maintained and operated efficiently;
- Records are prepared and maintained according to required procedures and standards;
- Reads charts accurately and maintains legible routine records of shift operations;
- Maintains and applies knowledge of the functions and servicing requirements of mechanical equipment and machinery, and of the treatment processes involved in the pumping and purification of water or wastewater, including some chemical tests;
- Understands and follows oral and written instructions;
- Ability to perform heavy physical work and ability to lift 75 pounds and to lift and carry up to 75 pounds;
- Ability to stand, walk, sit, bend, crawl, push, pull and perform a variety of similar body movements;
- Possesses hand/eye/foot coordination adequate to perform laboratory work and operate plant controls and valves, and a sludge truck;
- Ability to talk and hear in person, by telephone and two way radio; ability to hear mechanical malfunctions; ability to see and read instructions.
