Job Description


Four County Mental Health Center, Inc. has been an area provider of public mental health services since 1964. Historically, being the designated community mental health clinic meant that citizens of each county had access to only two services: Outpatient counseling and psychiatric/medication services. Over the past several years, our scope has increased to include more than 40 service programs designed to meet the unique needs associated with all ages and mental/behavioral health challenges.

- Connections DOT Drivers – This position transports individuals throughout the local communities. Must be 21 years of age or older. Eligible applicants must meet and comply with all DOT regulations. Starting wage is \$15.00/hour. (Part-Time/Cowley)
- Kids Konnections Attendant Care- This position consists of working one-on-one in a home-like setting with children ages 6 to 18 years old on the weekends. Staff will be responsible for the care of and activities for the child, while maintaining safety. We are seeking individuals who enjoy working with children, who are flexible, dependable and would like to earn extra money while doing something rewarding! Starting wage is \$14.28hour. (Part-Time Weekends)
- Community Health Center Integrated Care Therapist – This position is responsible for providing mental health services (individual, family, and group therapy) in a community healthcare setting as well as providing mental health consultation services to individuals and organizations in the community. Includes innovate collaboration and partnership with healthcare providers to positively influence positive health outcomes in the local



community. Requirements include a minimum of a master's degree from an accredited institution which provides graduate training in social work or PhD in psychology and potential applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure as an LCSW or PsyD in the State of Kansas. Salary offers will be negotiated based on regional rates. (Full-Time, office at CHC in Winfield)

- Crisis Support Specialist – This position works directly with our patients in the roles of observation and transportation. Must be able to demonstrate interpersonal skills, have the ability to work with persons with mental and/or physical impairments, and possess the ability to react effectively in a wide variety of human service situations.
 - Starting wage is: \$14.90/hour. Hours for this position are part-time prn (as needed).
- Medical Services Nurse Staff - Office based position will work directly with a psychiatrist and/or nurse practitioner. Primary duties include maintaining and managing the physician's schedule, providing medical assessments and provider support under the direction of the RN and/or physician as well as charting in an electronic health record. Staff licensed as Certified Medical Assistant, LPN or RN will also provide medication refills and injections and those who do not have these licenses will provide additional clerical support when needed to the department (answering phones, checking patient in, scheduling patient appointments). Applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure in Kansas. No nights or weekends and paid holidays! RN/LPN preferred but other listed license/certification types may be considered. Starting wage depends on licensure / job descriptions – positions will be paid hourly for part-time:
 - RN=Starting wage is \$26.00/hour Medical Services Registered Nurse
 - LPN= Starting wage is: \$22.00/hour Medical Services Licensed Practical Nurse
- Peer Recovery Mentor - This position consists of helping develop a network of information and support for others who have been through similar experiences as patients with substance abuse disorders and/or mental illness, assisting patients in regaining the ability to make independent choices and play an active role in their own treatment and sharing and supporting the use of recovery tools. The selected applicant must have a high school diploma or GED and a minimum of 2 years of demonstrated personal recovery experience. Hourly position: starting wage is \$29,702/year- \$14.28/hour. (Full-Time)
- Adult Employment Education Support Case Manager – This position is needed to partner with adults with severe and persistent mental illness to aide in working towards obtaining and maintaining employment, achieving set employment or academic goals and documenting progress made. Involves flexible hours and travel within the county



and surrounding area (agency will reimburse for mileage). Hourly position: starting wage is \$40,000/year – \$19.23/hour. (Full-Time)

- Connections Transportation Driver – This position transports individuals throughout the local communities. Must be 21 years of age or older and have the ability to safely assist and transport all customers using an agency vehicle. Starting wage is \$14.00/hour. (Part-Time)
- Crisis Diversion Services Therapist On-Call PRN – Position entails serving on an on-call rotation as needed, providing emergency services for both adults and children in the agency catchment area. Ability to provide excellent customer service to agency business partners and patients is a must. Added benefits for this position include: Enhanced salary rate for on-call coverage periods, opportunity for incentive pay and extra days off each month. Requires a minimum of a master's degree from an accredited institution which provides graduate training in social work, counseling, psychology, or marriage and family therapy. Potential applicants must be licensed or immediately eligible for licensure in Kansas. (Part Time)

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
