Job Description

Reports to: Shop Lead

Role: Responsible for performing welding repairs and brazing, preliminary, hidden-damage, in-process and final inspections on civil aviation articles in accordance with the current technical data provided in the manufacturer's instructions for continued airworthiness, Service Bulletins, service letters, Airworthiness Directives, government and industry standard practices, and other data acceptable to or approved by the FAA.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Perform welding and brazing repairs on stainless and aluminum alloys to standard.
- Perform TIG welding to standard.
- Ensuring that they are thoroughly familiar with cleaning, inspection methods, techniques, aids, tools and equipment used within their assigned area of responsibility.
- Maintaining proficiency in suing the inspection aids in their assigned areas of responsibility.
- Ensuring that the inspection tools and equipment, including inspection aids, used to perform inspections are in proper working order and the proper calibration information is affixed.
- Understand the current specifications involving inspection tolerances, limitations, and procedures established by the manufacturer of the article(s) being inspected.
- Ensure all cleaning, inspections and repairs are properly performed and recorded, and all records are properly executed before final approval for return to service of articles maintained or altered by this repair station.

Education and Experience:

- High school degree required, college or welding certification preferred.
- Experience and proficiency in TIG welding, brazing experience preferred.

Key Competencies:

- Is thoroughly familiar with the applicable FARs and with the inspection methods, techniques, practices, aids, equipment, and tools used to determine the airworthiness of the article on which maintenance, preventive maintenance, or alternations are being performed.
- IS proficient in using various types of mechanical and visual inspection aids appropriate for the articles being inspected and approved for return to service.
- Understands, reads, and writes English.
- Ability to work well in a team environment.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
- Problem analysis and problem-solving.
- Attention to detail and accuracy.
- Exhibits an extreme level of integrity.

Additional Requirements:

- Ability to complete welding competency test prior to hire.
