Summary/Objective:

The Packout Support role serves as a vital link between departments, ensuring smooth production operations by providing raw materials, verifying product counts, packaging, labeling, and removing finished products safely. The incumbent prioritizes safety, quality, and waste reduction throughout all tasks.

Essential Functions:

- Safely operate a forklift to transport raw materials and finished products within the production floor.
- Utilize computer systems to access product requirements and customer specifications.
- Deliver supplies and fixtures promptly to machine cells.
- Provide matching racks to the production floor as needed for finished products.
- Maintain appropriate inventory levels of active items and fixtures in the warehouse.
- Remove finished products from production cells for storage or internal transport.
- Prepare machine cells for the next production run by clearing and organizing materials.
- Ensure all products are clearly labeled and stored to prevent damage.
- Wrap products requiring machine wrapping according to customer specifications.
- Organize and maintain the pallet pad for accessibility and safety.
- Communicate effectively with truck support regarding required trailers and their movement.
