There will be two special questions for USD 465:

Proposition No. 1:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall Unified School District No. 465, Cowley County, Kansas (Winfield), issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$46,000,000, to pay the costs to construct, furnish and equip renovations, improvements and additions to District facilities, including: (a) a new elementary school facility anticipated to be located at the existing site of the District office; (b) improvements and additions to the existing Irving Elementary School for controlled entry and new classrooms, Whittier Elementary School for controlled entry and a new cafeteria, and Winfield Middle School for new classrooms, multi-purpose lab, and a storm shelter; (c) improvements and renovations to Lowell Elementary School to create a new Education Support Facility, including District offices, Cowley County Special Ed Co-op, Day School, Parents as Teachers, Gifted and Homebound support facilities; and (d) all other necessary improvements related thereto (collectively the “Project”), and to pay costs of issuance and interest on said general obligation bonds during construction of the Project; all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.*, K.S.A. 25-2018(f), K.S.A. 72-5457, and K.S.A. 72-5458 *et seq.*?

AND

Proposition No. 2:

Shall the following be adopted?

Shall Unified School District No. 465, Cowley County, Kansas (Winfield), issue general obligation bonds in an amount not to exceed \$8,700,000, to pay the costs to: (a) construct, furnish and equip a new Sports Complex for the Winfield Middle School and Winfield High School, including a turf football/soccer field, all-weather track, seating, and concessions/restroom building; (b) replace four of the existing tennis courts at T.H. Vaughn Tennis Complex with new courts; and (c) all other necessary improvements related thereto (collectively the “Project”), and to pay costs of issuance and interest on said general obligation bonds during construction of the Project; all pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 10-101 *et seq.*, K.S.A. 25-2018(f), K.S.A. 72-5457, and K.S.A. 72-5458 *et seq.*?

The voting hours for said General Election will be from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, November 8, 2022.
The voting places in Cowley County shall be as follows:

Qualified electors residing in the **city limits of Arkansas City**, will vote at, **Central Christian Church**, 206 W. Central, Arkansas City.

Qualified electors residing in the **city limits of Winfield**, will vote at, **Central Baptist Church**, 904 Wheat Road, Winfield.

Qualified electors residing in **Beaver and Pleasant Valley Townships**, will vote at **Pleasant Valley Township Hall**, 22277 71st Road, Winfield.

Qualified electors residing in **Bolton Township**, will vote at **Bolton Township Hall**, 6789 322nd Road, Arkansas City.

Qualified electors residing in **Cedar, Dexter (including Dexter City), Grant, Otter and Spring Creek Townships**, will vote at **Dexter City Building**, 113 S. Main, Dexter.

Qualified electors residing in **Creswell East(including Parkerfield)** and **Silverdale Townships**, will vote at **Parkerfield Community Center**, 29271 91st Road, Parkerfield.

Qualified electors residing in **West Creswell Township**, will vote at **Central Christian Church**, 206 W. Central, Arkansas City.

Qualified electors residing in **Fairview, Liberty, Salem, Tisdale, Vernon and Walnut Townships**, will vote at **Central Baptist Church**, 904 Wheat Road, Winfield.

Qualified electors residing in **Harvey, Omnia (including Atlanta) and Richland Townships**, will vote at **Cornerstone Christian Church**, 422 Main, Atlanta.

Qualified electors residing in **Maple(including Udall), Ninnescah (including Udall)** and **Rock Creek Townships**, will vote at **Udall Community Building**, 102 E. 1st, Udall.

Qualified electors residing in **Sheridan, Silver Creek (including Burden) and Windsor (including Cambridge) Townships**, will vote at **Burden City Building**, 401 N. Main, Burden.

Pursuant to K.S.A. 25-2430 Electioneering on Election Day within any polling place or within 250 feet from the entrance is prohibited. Electioneering means any attempt to persuade or influence by any means, eligible voters, to vote for or against a particular candidate, party or question submitted. Electioneering at polling places is a class C misdemeanor.
